The current list below identifies states in which the state higher education agencies' responded to recent inquiries from The Ohio State University, that their agencies exercise regulatory oversight of programs with "on-the-ground" (OTG) instructional components (clinicals, practica, internships, externships, etc.), **regardless of the mode of DELIVERY.**

What does this mean?

The state higher education agency has verified that it exercises its regulatory oversight of **DISTANCE EDUCATION** programs AND home state, campus-based **TRADITIONAL** programs with "on-the-ground" instructional components such as: clinicals, practica, internships, externships, etc.

The responses received from the agencies are subject to change due to evolving regulations, states' interpretations of regulations, and/or any other information regarding institutions' programs and components. Higher education institutions should rely on their own verifications of regulations. The responses received from the states listed below are specific to The Ohio State University's inquiries and should not be relied upon by other institutions, but could be used as a "starter" list to direct inquiries.
